The being on roller dating back to the middle ages. It has its roots in Germany. One could not previously recognize as master craftsmen without having to roll. It was here that they learned new craft traditions and designs, which created a better professional.

To correct some misconceptions, so is a "Naver" a craftsman from Scandinavia and master one of the three languages. The word Never comes from the word Scandinavians, and has been used for the traveling journeymen from Scandinavia.

CUK

Navernes association also CUK - and stands for central support box. It was founded in Winterthur in Switzerland.

Many thousands of Scandinavian craftsmen, of which the vast majority were Danish, traveled at the turn of the century in 1900 - and earlier - abroad and to improve their skills and to learn other countries' customs and traditions to know.

As early as the early 1870s, there were many young Danish craftsmen who went on the roller and worked around Europe. C.U.K. Today about 600 members, many of whom remain active outside Denmark.

We aim to bring together artisans who have been traveling with their subjects. We are trying to maintain the old traditions of craftsmanship - clothing, rituals and companionship.

We encourage young craftsmen to leave, and to improve their skills so they can achieve the full benefit of their craft.

We hold lectures in clubs and schools.

We inform and support the young people who want to get out and travel, and have them help with making contact abroad.

On the basis of the association's members' experience and contacts abroad, it is possible for us to give them support and guidance before they go out.

Been traveling with your craft, and not put your subject in disgrace, you can join the naverne.

You must have been out and travel at least one year and one day to become a member is not required on a particular subject you deny.

It is not a requirement that you have gone on "ROLLER" but have you been ROLLER, you will enjoy the privileges as a real hub will be awarded.

How do I Naver?

You / I may, for a living - and working abroad, which extends over one year and one day, seek out one of the local Naver Associations which will enlighten you on how to become registered.

If you / I've got work abroad and there is a local Naver Association, you / I, before departure from Denmark, sign up for Banking Services and become a member here.

Naver associations can help in various ways.

Eg. is a work - and residence is not always the easiest thing in the world to get and here Naver Association or the Banking assist with information.

Abroad, where there is a local Naver Association, there will always be help at hand. Both m.h.t. the local authorities, but also m.h.t. working since local navere have often stayed in the country for many years. There will always be help available for some rest and a meal.



Naver associations are not only for male members. Women who satisfy the condition, is more than welcome as members.

Likewise, Naver associations not only for persons whose birth certificate says 50 or 60+.

We want younger forces in the associations, so our over 100year old tradition can be continued for the benefit of future generations who want to leave the world to improve their skills.


